Dear Supporters,

Due to the COVID-19 situation, we have had to reschedule our golf tournament fundraiser to July 24, 2021. This is our main fundraising event for the Central New York SPCA. Even though there is no physical tournament, we are asking our sponsors and golfers for much needed donations.

Our Mission of the Central New York SPCA since its formation in 1891, has dealt with the issues of animal neglect and cruelty. Our founders began this organization because of the mistreatment of the mules pulling barges on the Erie Canal.

Stats:

- January 1, 2019-December 31, 2019 we rescued 590 animals from cruelty and took in 601 stray animals. We returned 181 animals to owners and adopted 1,127 animals.
- January 1, 2020 to date we have rescued 177 animals from cruelty and took in 215 stray animals. We have returned 81 strays to their owners and adopted 429 animals. Our staff has worked diligently and safely under the COVID-19 crisis. We are still continuing our efforts to serve our community.

Every day our cruelty investigators are rescuing animals in deplorable conditions and from a lifetime of cruelty, violence and incredible pain.

Your donation makes it possible for our mission to continue to fight animal cruelty and neglect and to create a happy ending for those precious lives touched by cruelty.

The Central New York SPCA will always continue to "Speak for those who can speak for themselves" and continue to educate the community of our mission.
